ON THE COVER Paul painted this aspect of the alley between 12th Avenue South and Broad Avenue South in Old Naples just before it was obscured from public view by fences and hedges. The Naples Historical Society recently transformed the home to the east of Palm Cottage on 12th Avenue South into the Smith Museum, enhancing the historical significance of this block.

INSIDE Each month includes one of the Paul Arsenault paintings above, descriptive information, and a vignette of some of the flowers that can be spotted in Southwest Florida. For stargazers, moon phases are included. The full moon names reflect those used by American Indian tribes to help track the seasons. Images suitable for framing.
